CRICKET INFRASTRUCTURE

- Proposal of two cricket pitches (Non - Permanent structure).
- Location of pitch to be between the tree and current barricade setup at Harmony ground. (Location can be changed later on)
- Pitch to have a thin layer of concrete which can be removed in due course of time to a permanent location (if needed)
- Pitch surface to have soft synthetic paint to match with the surrounding ground.
- Nets to be made of removable steel frame to address safety and easy mobilisation.





FOOTBALL INFRASTRUCTURE

- Proposal of steel frame barricading structure on Vista Ground towards Vista 05 & 06
- Barricading to be like the ones placed towards the pond end of Vista Ground.
- The steel frame barricading to provide safety cover to car parked behind the goal posts.





TENNIS INFRASTRUCTURE

- Revamp of current lawn tennis court.
 Current court has become uneven, resulting in injuries to the players
- Present surface to bee removed and court to be resurfaced with multiple layers synthetic paints/polymer/ chemical treatment.
- Court to reduce risk of injury to adults and kids.



INFRASTRUCTURE REGULATION

- Residents of UWC as well as coaching for Cricket, Football and Tennis to benefit from the proposed infrastructural developments.
- Coaches to submit details of students including flat details at end of every month.
- All students to have CAM charges cleared to avail coaching.
- Coaching fee to be regulated by Uniworld Sports Association. Discussion to be held with coaches for the same.
